as we begin to come out of the Covid Pandemic.

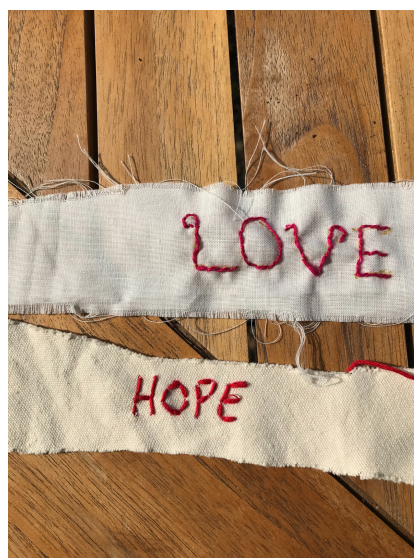
